### Apps:

Flora of Virginia – wonderful smart phone app with dichotomous and graphic keys, information on plant families, genera and species, photos, location maps by County, detailed botanical description of all plants in Virginia, and ability to save favorite plant lists by locality.

Seek by iNaturalist, draws on millions of observations on i-naturalist to allow you to photograph and use image recognition to identify a wide diversity of flora and fauna with a relatively high level of accuracy (for i-phones, i-pads and more)
